

Triathlon Ontario Membership Policy

Members of Triathlon Ontario are all approved applicants that have paid the appropriate a membership fee.

Classes of Membership

Currently classes of membership and their corresponding membership fees (inclusive of processing fees are as

- (a) Elite \$62
- (b) Elite Club \$52
- (c) Adult \$62
- (d) Adult Club \$52
- (e) Coach \$62
- (f) Coach Club \$52
- (g) Junior aged 16-19 as of December 31 of current year \$52
- (h) Junior Club aged 16-19 as of December 31 of current year \$47
- (i) Youth aged 15 and under as of December 31 of current year \$37
- (j) Youth Club aged 15 and under as of December 31 of current year \$32
- (k) Official \$0
- (l) Race Director \$0
- (m) Director \$0

One Day Members

One Day Members shall be a Member for one day being the day of the event for which the One Day Member paid their Triathlon Ontario Fee. One day members do not have voting rights nor are they covered under the sport accident insurance policy.

Members in Good Standing

A Member shall be considered in good standing with Triathlon Ontario when:

- (a) the Membership fee for that member has been paid for the current year and for the additional period of 30 days beyond Triathlon Ontario's annual renewal date.
- (b) there are no charges payable to Triathlon Ontario by such member which remain outstanding for a period of 60 days for items and services provided by Triathlon Ontario to the member including but not limited to clinics, camps, banquets, clothing orders, etc.

Transfer of Membership

A membership in Triathlon Ontario is not transferable, and lapses and ceases to exist upon death of the member, or dissolution of Triathlon Ontario.

Revocation of Membership

Any member may be expelled from Triathlon Ontario by a two-thirds votes taken by ballot of the members present and eligible to vote at an annual or other general meeting of members.

Notice of such meeting designating the time and place of the meeting and the reasons for the proposed revocation of such membership shall be forwarded to the member in question at least seven days prior to the date of the meeting of the members. Notice of the meeting shall indicate that the member in question shall be afforded an opportunity for a hearing before the members of Triathlon Ontario.

Termination

A membership in Triathlon Ontario automatically terminates upon the happening of any of the following events:

- (a) if the member, in writing, resigns as a member of Triathlon Ontario;
- (b) if the member dies;
- (c) if the member is expelled from Triathlon Ontario pursuant to section 7.10 of the by-laws; or
- (d) if any assessment under the authority of section 7.01 or section 7.12 of the by-laws remains unpaid for more than 60 days after the notice of the assessment has been given to the member. Notwithstanding termination of membership, a former member remains liable for any assessment levied under the authority of section 7.01 or section 7.12 of the by-laws prior to termination of his/her membership.
